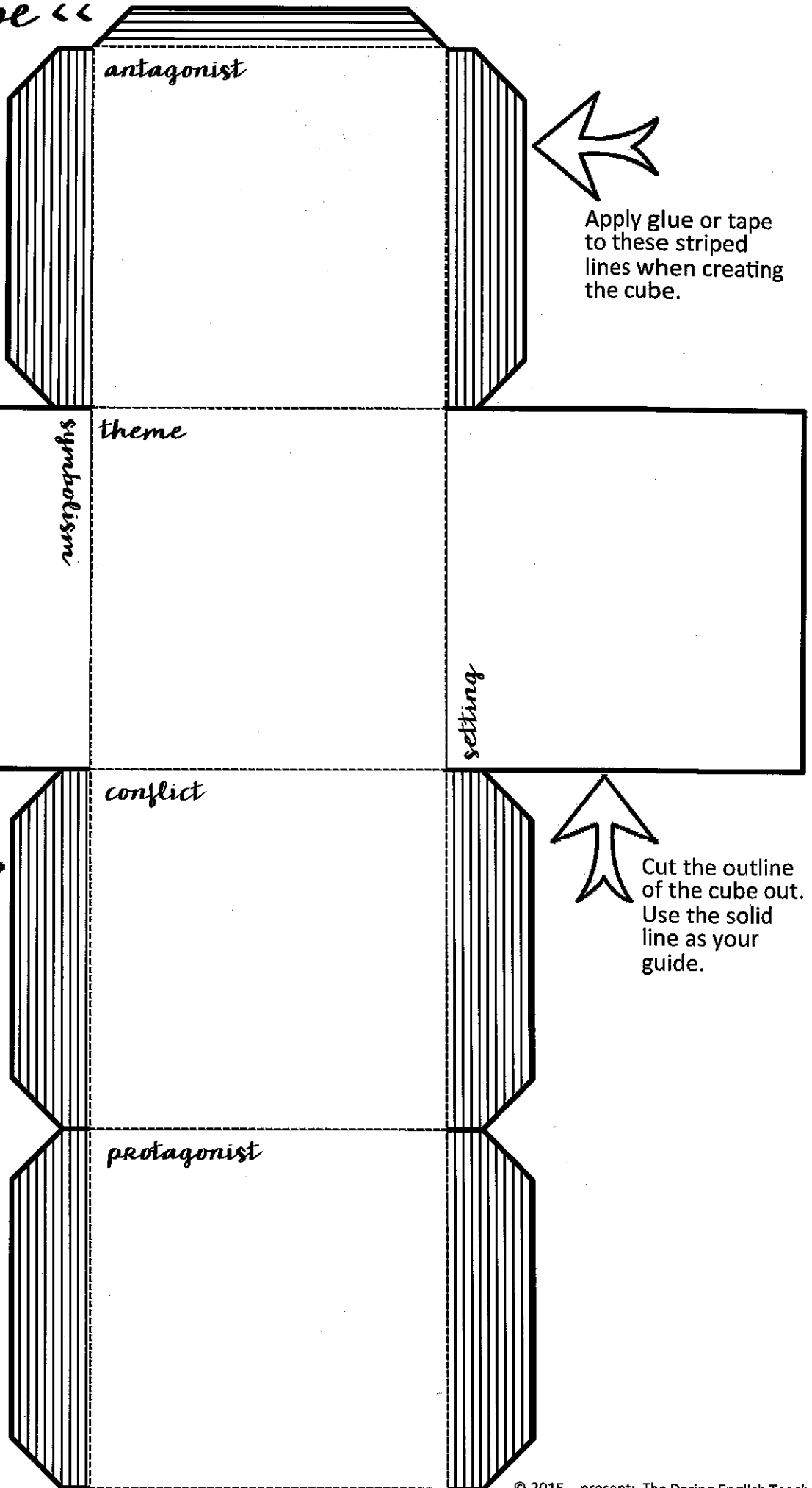


# >> Story Cube <<
